WEEKLY UPDATE BULLETIN

Please find the latest information below for works commencing in your area from Friday 12th January 2018.



May we take this opportunity to wish you all a very *Happy New Year*.

2018 will be a busy year on the scheme. We are extremely grateful for the patience, understanding and support you have shown us during 2017, and we will work hard to continue to receive this from you through 2018.

Current Road Closures

- **Middle Dolfor Road.** As previously advised we are looking to open the road intermittently from Monday 8th January 2018 until Friday 30th March 2018. We will need to temporarily close the road while works are being carried out overhead on the bridge deck. We will endeavor to open the road at weekends and weekdays when it is safe to do so.

PLEASE NOTE for the week commencing Monday 15th January 2018 we will be carrying out works on the bridge. The road will therefore be closed during the working day, between the hours of 7:30am and 5:00pm. We will maintain escorted pedestrian access.

- **Hollies Lane.** Is closed to accommodate scaffolding on the lane. Pedestrian access will be maintained. ***The lane will remain closed until March/April 2018.***

Traffic Management

- **Black Hall Farm and A489 towards Kerry.** There are currently intermittent temporary traffic lights in place at Black Hall Farm and on the A483 towards Kerry for plant to cross safely during working hours.
- **A483 Pool Road.** Temporary traffic lights will continue along Pool Road, as and when necessary, to carry out essential works.

Concrete Pours

- We have a concrete pour planned for Wednesday 17th January 2018 for Mochdre Bridge. The road at Mochdre Bridge, will be temporarily closed between the hours of 9:00am and 4:00pm. Residents will need to use the signed diversion route. Emergency vehicles, refuse vehicles, pedestrians and the school buses will be allowed access through the closure as per the same arrangement as the last closure.

The concrete pour is weather dependent so the date could change but we will communicate any changes as soon as we are able to.

Please note this concrete pour was originally planned to take place on Friday 16th February 2018 and previously notified as such. The revised date is because of works being ahead of schedule.

Additional Information

- We will be carrying out works to the South Abutment of the Railway Bridge over the coming weekend, Saturday 13th and Sunday 14th January 2018, between the hours of 7:30am and 4:00pm. The works will include erecting shuttering and steel fixing in preparation for a concrete pour on Thursday 25th January 2018.
